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SVC Generative AI Policy (Rev 1.1, September 15, 2026)

The SVC recognizes that there are many AI tools available to assist in the generation of presentations, manuscripts, and posters.

The SVC policy for manuscripts closely follows guidelines in place for many scholarly and professional organizations and are detailed in the template that all submissions to the SVC Proceedings (starting with the SVC 2027 Conference Proceedings) must follow. The 2027 manuscript template is available for download from the [“Presenter/Author Guidelines”](#) section of the [SVC TechCon website](#).

Submissions to the annual special edition of Elsevier’s peer-reviewed Surface and Coatings Technology journal are governed exclusively by specific [Elsevier/S&CT formatting requirements and Generative AI policies](#).

Oral and Poster presentations made at the SVC TechCon and SVC affiliated workshops rely on the presenter’s transparent and ethical use of AI tools to generate text and graphics. Presenters are responsible for all submitted content including the accuracy of AI-generated content. For works of scientific or technical reference value, AI and/or digital twin use should be disclosed when it has the potential to affect the findings or conclusions of an article, including but not limited to

- *Analysis of content, data, or images,*
- *Designing or conducting experiments, and*
- *Extracting or synthesizing information.*

Such uses of AI and/or digital twins should be described in detail in appropriate acknowledgements and/or footnotes embedded in the presentation. To increase transparency and reproducibility, the description must include the exact tool (name, version, manufacturer), what the tool was used for, and the reason for using it for the task. Generative AI should not be used to create, alter, or manipulate original research data results or make adjustments to original images that alter the accuracy or interpretation of the original material.

SVC editors and peer reviewers are prohibited from uploading an unpublished presentation and/or manuscript into a generative AI tool so that the confidentiality and ownership of the source materials is respected.

SVC editors may, at their discretion, determine that the AI use in a given submission is too extensive, including (but not limited to) AI tools used to generate substantive commentary and analysis. This determination may result in rejection of submitted work or a request for revision to remove or reduce AI-generated portions of the manuscript, PowerPoint presentation, or poster submitted to the SVC for publication.
